FIVE questions to be attempted.

1. Write an account of Man's experiences in the Garden of Eden, and give your interpretation of the two trees, the serpent, and the expulsion from the Garden.
2. Relate and consider critically the story of Cain and Abel.
3. "The predominant picture of Abraham's piety is faith in the Unseen." Discuss this statement.
4. In what ways did the lives of the Hebrews change from the time of Joseph to the time of Moses? How do you account for these changes?
5. Write an essay on Hebrew poetry with reference to three examples from the prescribed books.
6. Narrate and comment on God's call to Moses and his response to it.
7. Consider the significance and importance of the story of Balak and Balaam in the history of Israel.
8. Show clearly how the books of Joshua and Judges differ in their accounts of the entry of the tribes of Israel into Canaan and their settlement there.
9. How do the Samson stories differ from the stories of the other Judges?
10. Give an account of the religion of Israel in the time of Eli and the early life of Samuel.
11. Write an essay on EITHER Samuel as a religious leader OR the Philistines.
12. Write notes on the following:- The punitive expedition of Chedorlaomer; the Divine Name; Korah, Dathan, Abiram.
